



Walmart Autoimmune Care Program

The Walmart Autoimmune Care Program is a nationally available, pharmacy based care model designed to support patients living with autoimmune conditions. The program includes additional pharmacist training and expanded clinical services to support the management of complex autoimmune treatment regimens and continuity of care for patients across Canada.

Conditions supported include:

- Rheumatoid arthritis
- Psoriatic arthritis
- Plaque psoriasis
- Atopic dermatitis
- Inflammatory bowel diseases, including Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis

How the Autoimmune Care Program Supports Your Patients

Clinical pharmacy services

- Pharmacists with dedicated training in autoimmune specialty therapies, including biologics and immunomodulators
- Familiarity in administration, monitoring considerations, and adherence challenges associated with autoimmune treatments

Medication management & administration

- Support for autoimmune medication management to optimize patient health outcomes
- Support for subcutaneous and intramuscular injection administration (where within scope). Patient or caregiver injection training, when applicable

Access & coverage

- Collaboration with Patient Support Programs (PSPs) to assist with prior authorization and coverage processes, helping minimize delays in treatment initiation
- Assistance addressing reimbursement and access related concerns

Ongoing monitoring & follow up

- Ongoing pharmacist follow up aligned with therapy complexity
- Monitoring for adverse effects, drug interactions, comorbidities, and laboratory work as appropriate
- Proactive communication with prescribers when clinically relevant

A collaborative model of care

The Walmart Autoimmune Care Program is designed to support prescriber led care through a collaborative pharmacy model. Pharmacists work within their regulated scope of practice and in collaboration with prescribers to support:

- Medication adherence
- Identification of administration, tolerability, or access related issues
- Continuity of care to optimize therapy via prescriber updates

Accessible and integrated care

- Care delivered through conveniently located Walmart Pharmacy locations across Canada (excluding Quebec)
- Integration with patients' routine pharmacy visits, enabling coordinated access to autoimmune therapies alongside other medications and services
- Patients can conveniently pick up or have both their specialty and regular medications delivered in a single visit, ensuring easy, accessible therapy support
